

Chyan is only 4 or so miles from both Penryn and Falmouth; but it's not on a major road or bus route — its relative remoteness is what makes it so special — so getting there can be a little challenging.

BY CAR

From Falmouth roundabout on A39 take A394 towards Helston. Travel through Longdowns until left hand turn to Herniss. Follow this small road for about 2 miles; you'll got through the hamlet of Halvasso, and then BF Adventure centre on your left. Another 1/4 mile on, you'll see a turning on your right to a variety of house names — Jobs Water, Maen Rock, Treworvack etc; do *not* go down there, instead continue for 50m more to enter Chyan car-park on
