As a school we promise to:

- ensure your child's physical and social well being at all times, and foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging
- deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child
- encourage good behaviour and conduct through the Behaviour Policy (including anti-bullying)
- ensure that your child achieves their full potential as a valued member of the school community
- keep you informed about general school matters and meet with you to discuss your child's individual progress
- be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school.

As parents we promise to :

- make sure my child attends school regularly and arrives at school on time for registration at 8.55a.m
- make sure my child is properly equipped with suitable clothing, PE kit, reading book
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- support the school's Behaviour Policy and encourage the Golden Rules (see overleaf)
- attend Parent's Evening meetings and discussions about my child's progress at school.

As pupils we promise to:

- come to school every day and be on time
- take care of my uniform and belongings, remembering to bring my PE kit into school each week
- have good manners
- have pride in and take care of my school equipment and grounds
- be a Golden Citizen and follow the Golden Rules
- do my best .

REWARDS:

GOLDEN CITIZENS - Each week teachers award children with the title of Golden Citizen in recognition of following all Golden Rules and making our school a better place to be. Children will receive their certificate in celebration assembly and be celebrated on the website. All children following Golden Rules will be awarded limitless raffle tickets to be in the draw for winning a half termly Golden experience! Ask your child each week how many raffle tickets they have won. Team points will be awarded for hard work, effort and progress.

SANCTIONS:

Break any Golden Rule - photo card turned to red side.


Break any Golden Rule second time - 5 min Golden Time loss; parent informed by classteacher.

Break any Golden rule again - incremental Golden Time loss of up to 25 minutes. Child and classteacher to report to a member of the senior leadership team.

Any form of physical violence will lead to loss of whole breaktime with classteacher. A second incident of physical violence will lead to exclusion and loss of access to after school clubs for that half term.
