Pupil Premium Funding

Extra funding is available for our school for families who qualify for Pupil Premium. Are you in receipt of any of the following?

- Child Tax Credit (provided you're also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Guaranteed Element of State pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit Run-On (Paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit

We can help your child with this extra funding so please speak to the office as soon as possible if you think you may be eligible to apply. Thank you
