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Dear Parents and Carers,

I am not sure where the year went! All of a sudden we are here celebrating all the amazing achievements the children have made this year and giving our wonderful year 6's an amazing send off.

It's been a year of trying hard to reinstate many of the things that the children did well before Covid came. Not an easy task when the school has been faced with 4 spikes of Covid in one year as well as many other ailments. It has been at times very tricky but I am pleased to say that working as a team St Mary's has come through it stronger and in a great place to spring board into the future. We still have more work to do but I know that the children at St Mary's will rise to the challenge and make even greater strides next year to close the gaps in learning and engage enthusiastically with the new curriculum ideas.

We have all been very busy in the background implementing many new initiatives this year including piloting Power Maths at the school. We have decided to roll this out across the school next year to all classes whilst also retaining our good practice in reasoning and arithmetic. Our curriculum continues to be reviewed and we have developed a clear and cohesive curriculum which builds key components of knowledge of time alongside key skills. We will be sending out more information about this in September too.

We will also continue to develop the outside area of the school ensuring children are developing healthy lifestyles through access to PE, play and outdoor learning.

Our focus for next year includes reading, writing and mathematics as we feel that these three key skills will be again part of our drive to improve standards across the school. We will be embarking on Talk for Writing refresh training with St Mary's Falmouth, developing a reading spine of good quality books for pupils to read in their year groups and continuing to develop fluency and mastery in mathematics.

We will continue to build our wonderful school community, running events; parents' meetings and also having plays and productions at Christmas and throughout the year, monthly mass in our church and building on all the wonderful things that we were able to do this year.
