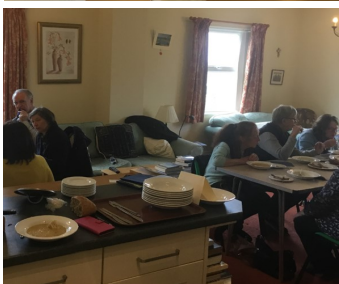

Please ensure all uniform is named.

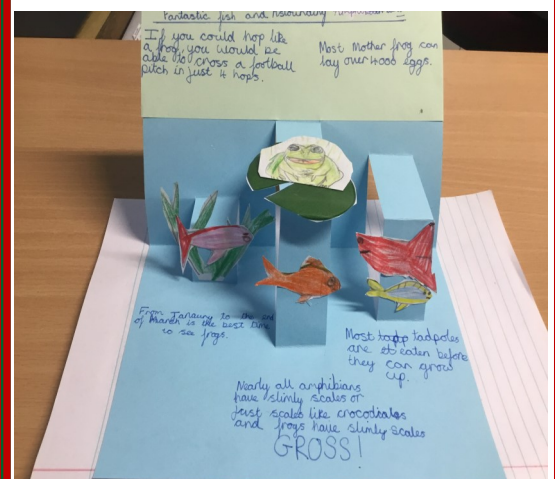
We are wasting a huge amount of time trying to reunite pupils with their clothing.

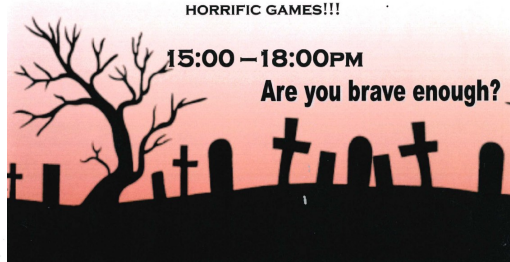
